

CLEP (College Level Examination Program) is a nationally-recognized and administered college-level examination program offered by the College Board (which also administers the AP-Advanced Placement and SAT Exam programs). Many CLEP examinations cover material taught in similar courses offered at Central College; other CLEP examinations cover material that is not directly equivalent to currently-offered Central courses, but that is deemed by Central to be the kind of material covered in courses offered at other colleges and universities whose curricula and academic requirements are similar to Central's and, therefore, worthy of Central College transfer credit.

In accordance with the credit recommendations of the American Council on Education (ACE), students must earn a minimum score of 50 on a CLEP exam to be granted Central College academic credit. Specific CLEP-Central College credit and course equivalencies are detailed in the table below. *Important: For Central College credit to be granted for a CLEP exam, students must request that CLEP/The College Board send directly to Central College's Academic Records & Registration office an official CLEP exam transcript.*
