Outstanding INSTRUCTORS

Camp co-director GARRY LAIDLAW

Garry Laidlaw is entering his 12th year as Central's men's soccer coach.

Inheriting a program that had never previously approached the .500 mark, Laidlaw engineered a turnaround which has produced a 93-34-9 (.716) mark over the past seven years.

Laidlaw was tabbed as the Iowa Conference coach of the year for the second time in 2008, after guiding his team to a 7-1 league mark. Previously Laidlaw served as head boys' soccer coach at Central High School in Champaign, Ill., for five seasons and also piloted the girls' squad for one year.

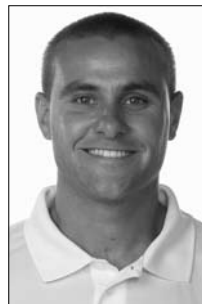
Born in England, Laidlaw grew up playing soccer in South Africa and Canada. He received his bachelor's and master's degrees from Eastern Illinois University where he was a three-time all-conference player and team captain. He was also a two-time all-region pick and was named the Mid-Continent Conference player of the year.

Camp co-director COLIN KUCHY

Colin Kuchy is entering his second season as head women's soccer coach at Central.

Kuchy previously served as an assistant for the men's squad for a year, following a season as head coach for Mount Zion (Ill.) High School and the Mid-State Soccer Club in Decatur, Ill. after earlier stints as a coach for clubs in St. Louis, Mo. He also spent a year as the junior varsity coach at St. Ambrose University. Kuchy was event manager for Street Soccer Cup USA in St. Louis.

A four-year starter and a team co-captain for St. Ambrose University, Kuchy is a San Antonio, Texas, native. He attended high school in Nashville, Tenn., where he played in three state tournaments and also gained extensive club experience.



Camp instructor KYLE HALFPOP

Kyle Halfpop, entering his second season as assistant men's soccer coach at Central. A 2005 Central graduate, Halfpop is one of the top scorers in school history and a three-time all-Iowa Conference selection. He was also a second-team all-West Region honoree as well as Central team MVP in 2004.
