Located 40 miles southeast of Des Moines, Central offers its 1,700 students learning opportunities not only on the Pella campus, but on branch campuses in London, England; Merida, Mexico; Leiden, the Netherlands; and Bangor, Wales; and at study centers in Granada, Spain; Hangzhou, China; Paris, France; and Vienna, Austria.

Central is a member of the National Collegiate Athletic Association, Division III, and the Iowa Intercollegiate Athletic Conference. Men compete in baseball, football, basketball, tennis, golf, wrestling, soccer, track and cross country while women compete in tennis, golf, track, softball, volleyball, cross country, soccer and basketball.

The A.N. Kuyper Athletics Complex

The A.N. Kuyper Athletics Complex is located at the corner of Independence Street and West Fifth Street in southwest Pella. The complex includes P.H. Kuyper Gymnasium (1970), H.S. Kuyper Fieldhouse (1987), Ron and Joyce Schipper Stadium (1977), the baseball and softball fields (1978), Ryerson Golf Driving Range (2005), tennis courts (1992), soccer field (2005), cross country course (2005) and the Ron Schipper Fitness Center (1999). The complex also includes practice and intramural softball, soccer and football fields. Golf meets are held at the Bos Landen Golf Club, two miles southwest of the campus on Highway T-15.

Mike Boschee

Head coach

Mike Boschee is entering his seventh season as head men's basketball coach at Central College.

A graduate of the University of North Dakota and a Valley City, N.D. native, Boschee was an all-North Central Conference and all-region player. He served as captain of the 1989-90 North Dakota squad that reached the final four of the NCAA Division II national tournament. The team was inducted into the university's hall of fame in the fall. Boschee remains North Dakota's all-time career free throw percentage leader (88.0), leading the nation in 1988-89 (92.8). He still ranks among North Dakota's top-25 all-time scorers with 1,103 points, is third in career 3-point goals (198) and sixth in 3-point percentage (40.0).

Boschee earned his master's degree from Northern State University (N.D.) and served as a graduate assistant coach for a team that reached the NAIA national championship game.

From 1993-2003, Boschee was an assistant at Gustavus Adolphus College (Minn.), serving as defensive coordinator. The Gusties posted a 221-83 record in that span, and made seven NCAA Division III playoff appearances, reaching the national title game in 2003. He also served as the Gustavus Adolphus head women's golf coach, earning coach of the year honors from the Minnesota Women's Collegiate Golf Association in 1998 and from the Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference in 2000 and 2003.

Inducted into the Valley City (N.D.) High School Hall of Fame in 2006, Boschee served as a team captain and all-conference selection in basketball, football and baseball, while earning all-state recognition in basketball and football.

A highly regarded clinician, Boschee has been featured at numerous camps and clinics. He's made steady progress in rebuilding the Central program, piloting the Dutch to a 14-10 mark in 2007-08, the program's highest victory total in 14 years. His teams posted a 62-89 record in his first six seasons of turning around the Dutch program, taking Central to the Iowa Conference tournament five times.

Boschee and his wife Amy have a son, Jaxon.

Assistants

Joe Steinkamp

Joe Steinkamp is entering his fifth season on the Dutch staff and his third year as the top varsity assistant. A 2003 Central graduate, he was a two-time letterwinner and the team co-captain in 2002-03. He spent the 2003-04 year as a graduate assistant women's basketball coach at Loras College while pursuing a master's degree. He was Central's men's junior varsity coach in 2004-05 and a volunteer assistant at Lewis University (Ill.) in 2005-06 before returning to Central as JV coach for 2006-07.

Marv Van Wyk

Long-time Pella Christian High School assistant Marv Van Wyk is in his first season as an assistant coach, working with the junior varsity and also serving as a varsity assistant. A Pella native, Van Wyk was an assistant at Pella Christian for 18 seasons, including 16 years as head sophomore coach, compiling a 226-63 record. From 2004-08 Van Wyk was also involved with Future Stars Basketball, serving as a coach for Future Stars club teams and providing instruction at camps. He was named the Future Stars summer program coach of the year in 2004, 2005, 2007 and 2008. In 2009 he coached Iowa Magic Basketball's age 19-and-under club squad. Active in the Iowa Basketball Coaches Association, Van Wyk received the Roushar-Evans Service Award from the IBCA in 2008.

Brandon Townsend

Brandon Townsend is in his second season as assistant men's basketball coach at Central, working primarily with the junior varsity.

Townsend is also in his third year as an assistant baseball coach at Central, serving as pitching coach.

Townsend spent the 2006-07 year as head pitching coach, recruiting coordinator and junior varsity coach at North Central College (Ill.) after a year as pitching coach and assistant recruiting coordinator at North Park College (Ill.). He is a 2005 graduate of North Central where he was a two-year team captain. He also has experience as a youth league coach and as a private pitching instructor.

In 2009, Townsend coached a summer wood-bat league team to the ABCCCL title in New Jersey.

Townsend received a master's degree in athletic administration from California Univ. (Pa.).

Outlook

Central College enters the 2009-10 men's basketball campaign with the deepest and most experienced squad in Mike Boschee's seven seasons as head coach.

Whether that translates into becoming an Iowa Conference title contender is uncertain, but Boschee said his veteran players know what needs to be done.

"They understand what it takes to be successful in the Iowa Conference," he said. "They understand the effort they have to give each night and they know how well we have to execute to be successful."

Point guard

All five starters return from last year's 13-13 squad, led by two-time all-conference point guard Miguel Ley, a 6-foot senior. He was the league's scoring leader with a 17.4-point average while passing out 3.0 assists. A four-year starter, Ley is 17th on Central's all-time scoring list with 1,053 points.

Ley is more than a scorer.

"Miguel continues to improve his game and ability to play the point," Boschee said. "He's very explosive and a good shooter. He's becoming better at running our team."

Boschee is looking at three other players as backups, most notably 5-11 senior DeMarco Turner, who appeared in 17 games last year.

"DeMarco is a quick guard who shoots it very well," Boschee said. "He can be a spark for us."

Brock Caves, a 5-10 sophomore, is up from the junior varsity.

"He's got a burst to him and has improved his shooting quite a bit," Boschee said. "He's doing a lot of things well right now. We are very pleased with his development."

Adrian Cave, a 5-10 freshman from Springfield, Ill., has also forced his way into the conversation.

"Adrian is very quick and a good shooter," Boschee said. "He's a true point guard. He's good in transition and he runs the team well at a young age."

Off guard/small forward

Seniors Justin Madsen (6-0) and Mark Holan (6-4) handled the wing positions last year.

Madsen averaged 6.8 points and 2.4 rebounds and was the team's best 3-point shooter. He averaged 1.5 treys a game, hitting 36.1 percent.

"Justin's a good shooter and gets after it defensively," Boschee said. "We think he will be even better from 3-point range this year."

Holan was the team's third-leading scorer, averaging 8.5 points with 4.5 rebounds.

"Mark plays with a lot of intensity," Boschee said. "He brings it every day in practice. He's a hard-nosed play-

er.”

Another blue-collar player, 6-5 junior James Chapline, was also in the wing rotation. He averaged 6.4 points and 4.4 rebounds.

“He’s a tough, hard-nosed player,” Boschee said. “He’s a great rebounding guard and he’s improved his shooting. He seems to be more confident than a year ago. I really like the energy he brings.”

Central has some additional options this year. Cy Winn, a 6-4 senior, transferred from Graceland Univ. for his final collegiate season.

“Cy is good offensively,” Boschee said. “He could pose match-up problems for some smaller guards.”

Boschee also likes a freshman, 6-4 Jacob Winkler of Lancaster, Mo.

“He’s a good offensive player who can pass and shoot,” he said. “He also has a good post up game.

Up from the junior varsity is 6-2 junior Marko Marinkovich.

“Marko’s got a good work ethic and shoots the ball pretty well,” Boschee said.

Power forward/center

Big men are scarce commodities in Division III but the Dutch have two good ones in seniors Loren Liming (6-7) and Zach Cooper (6-9). Liming blossomed last year, averaging 12.0 points and 6.3 rebounds while shooting a team-high 57.3 percent from the floor with 1.4 blocks.

“Loren’s floor game has improved in a lot of areas,” Boschee said. “His post moves are much better. I think you’ll see a much improved Loren Liming compared to a year ago.”

Cooper’s been a defensive stopper. He averaged 1.8 blocks and 6.1 rebounds while scoring 5.7 points a game.

“Zach’s continued to develop,” Boschee said. “He’s a very good defensive player but has continued to develop his offensive game. His post moves are a little cleaner than a year ago.”

Central added depth with 6-5 sophomore Jack Bruns, a transfer from Kirkwood Community College.

“He’s a good offensive player that uses his size and strength very well,” Boschee said. “I think he’ll also be a good rebounder. We will need his physical play.”

Preston Davidson, a 6-6 senior, is a three-time letterwinner. He averaged 3.2 points and 2.5 rebounds off the bench last season.

“Preston’s been a pretty good defensive player for us and continues to develop offensively,” Boschee said. “He has plenty of experience that we can always count on.”

Chris Lehmann, a 6-6 sophomore, showed promise on the junior varsity last year and could work his way into the rotation.

“Chris has improved his outside shooting,” Boschee said. “We hope he can stretch the floor offensively.”

Also up from the JV is 6-4 sophomore Matt Thornton.

“Matt’s a good offensive player with an uncanny ability to score inside,” Boschee said. “If you let him catch it down low, he’s probably going to score.”

The freshmen

Boschee likes his freshman class. With a senior-dominated lineup, available varsity playing time will be sparse but opportunities will soon arise.

“It’s a good group both athletically and academically,” Boschee said. “It’s a well-balanced class and a talented group that needs to step up and be ready to play a big role next year following the graduation of our seven seniors.”

The season

Outside shooting to complement Central’s efficient inside game was a point of emphasis for the players in the off-season and Boschee thinks he’s seeing progress.

“I’m optimistic about our shooting,” Boschee said. “Some of the guys that needed to address it have addressed it. But I’m not going to dwell on it. I just hope the guys will shoot with confidence and be complete players both offensively and defensively.”

Boschee would also like some up-tempo play.

“We need to be better in transition and take advantage of scoring opportunities better than we did a year ago,” he said. “We weren’t getting enough easy baskets.

“I think we understand what we’re doing offensively better than last year. We put in a new system last year and it seems much more natural for us this year.”

But Boschee doesn’t want the Dutch to forget his traditional defensive emphasis.

“I think we have the potential to be a better offensive team,” he said. “But we’re a little behind defensively from where I thought we’d be, probably because of the influx of new players. Defensively you’re only as good as your weakest link. When the season starts we hope to be one of the league’s best defensive teams again.”

Central tied for fifth in the Iowa Conference last year and even with an improved club, climbing in the standings will require a determined effort.

“The league is as strong as ever,” Boschee said. “It’s more balanced this year. Each night you have to be ready to play or you’ll get beat. It should be exciting.”

The non-conference schedule will test the Dutch as well, particularly the Westmont Tom Byron Classic in Santa Barbara, Calif. Dec. 29-30. Host Westmont (Calif.) is a traditional NAIA power.

“In the non-conference schedule we’ll see teams of various styles,” Boschee said. “That will help prepare us for the conference season.”

The Dutch are ready.

“I’m just excited to get going,” Boschee said.
