Founded in 1853, Central College is a four-year coeducational liberal arts college of the Reformed Church in America. Located 40 miles southeast of Des Moines, Central offers its 1,750 students learning opportunities not only on the Pella campus, but on branch campuses in London and Colchester, England; Merida, Yucatan, Mexico; Leiden, the Netherlands; and Carmarthen, Wales; and at study centers in Granada, Spain; Paris, France; and Vienna, Austria.

Central is a member of the National Collegiate Athletic Association, Division III, and the Iowa Intercollegiate Athletic Conference. Men compete in baseball, football, basketball, tennis, golf, wrestling, soccer, track and cross country while women compete in tennis, golf, track, softball, volleyball, cross country, soccer and basketball. Rugby is offered at the club level.

#### **The Kuyper Athletics Complex**

The Kuyper Athletics Complex is located at the corner of Independence Street and West Fifth Street in southwest Pella. The complex includes P.H. Kuyper Gymnasium (1970), H.S. Kuyper Fieldhouse (1987), A.N. Kuyper Field (1977), the baseball and softball fields (1978), Ryerson Golf Driving Range (2002), tennis courts (1992), soccer field (2005) and the Ron Schipper Fitness Center (1999). The complex also includes practice and intramural softball diamonds and football fields. Golf meets are held at the Bos Landen Golf Resort, two miles southwest of the campus on Highway T-15.

### Coaching staff

#### Kent Clayberg

##### Head coach

Kent Clayberg is entering his fourth season as head volleyball coach and his seventh year on the Central volleyball staff. He was an assistant coach for four years before being promoted to associate head coach in 2002 and then head coach in 2003.

A 1990 Central graduate, Clayberg has compiled a 54-19 record in two seasons as head coach, winning two Iowa Conference titles and two NCAA Division III playoff berths. He shared Iowa Conference coach of the year honors in 2003.

Clayberg has been an instrumental part of a Dutch program which has produced three NCAA Division III championships, nine NCAA playoff berths and nine consecutive Iowa Conference titles, with 14 league crowns overall.

He has twice been selected to coached all-star squads in international competition through USA Athletes International, Inc. He coached a Division III team in the Netherlands in 2001 and took a squad of Division II all-stars to the Northern University Games in Cairn, Australia in 2005.

He previously was an elementary school teacher at Boone, Iowa. He earned a master's degree in education with a concentration in exercise physiology from Iowa State University. He was a student coach for the Cyclone volleyball team for one season and served as a club coach as well. Clayberg is also an assistant director of admission at Central.

#### Catie Brand

##### Assistant coach

Catie Brand is in her second season as assistant volleyball coach at Central.

Brand, a 2004 Central graduate, was a four-year volleyball letterwinner for the Dutch. The Davenport, Iowa native was a three-time NCAA Division III tournament participant, and a member of Central's 2000 national championship squad. Brand was a first-team All-Iowa Conference and All-AVCA Division III Central Region selection in 2003 and was twice named the Iowa Conference female athlete of the week. A team co-captain and MVP, Brand closed her career ranking fourth on Central's career kills charts (1,224) and sixth in career blocks (350).

Brand served as a junior high volleyball coach in LeMars for one year and now is a teacher at the Pella Middle School.

#### Sunny Eighmy

##### Assistant coach

Sunny Eighmy is in her second season as assistant volleyball coach, working with the junior varsity.

A Guthrie Center, Iowa native, Eighmy is a 1999 Central graduate. She lettered once in volleyball and women's track and field for the Dutch. Eighmy also serves as director of alumni relations for the college.

**Outlook**

For the second straight year, the Central College volleyball team is faced with replacing an Iowa Conference MVP at middle hitter.

Coach Kent Clayberg hopes the Dutch answer the challenge as well as last year's club. Central captured a record 10th consecutive league title and its 15th overall, posting a 26-10 record and earning the program's 10th NCAA Division III tourney berth.

Four of last year's six starters are back with the starting libero returning as well as the Dutch look to build on a tradition which has seen them appear in 100 consecutive AVCA Division III top-25 rankings, a streak which began in 1997.

"These players are very smart, very athletic, very competitive and very committed to Central volleyball," Clayberg said. "It should be a fun team to coach."

**Middle hitter**

Filling the middle hitter position will be a preseason focus.

After losing Iowa Conference MVP Jamie Stark to graduation after the 2004 season, fellow middle hitter Katie Pederson followed with league MVP honors of her own. Meanwhile Katie Johnson earned first-team all-conference honors as she took over Stark's spot. Johnson, a 6-foot-1 junior, averaged 2.25 kills and 0.85 blocks while posting a team-high .305 attack percentage.

Clayberg expects Johnson to become an even more dominant player this fall, but acknowledges the importance of securing the other middle hitter position.

"I feel confident in Garra Williams and Megan Hansen," Clayberg said. "They are two players who have developed in the program for a couple of years and gained varsity experience last fall. They're strong, athletic and have great potential. I'm confident those two will step up and give us another strong middle hitter offensive and defensive attack."

Williams and Hansen are both 6-0 juniors and should also get help from 5-11 sophomore Melanie Gorter.

#### **Outside hitter**

Central has a position to fill on the outside but has plenty of experience. Alicia Whisner, a 5-9 senior, opened the year as a starter but was sidelined by injury midway through the season. The three-time letterwinner and two-time team co-captain averaged 2.03 kills and 2.92 digs while hitting .118 in 20 matches last year. She recorded four statistical double-doubles.

Ali Ripperger, a 5-9 junior, took over for Whisner and averaged 2.05 kills with 1.0 digs and a .196 attack percentage.

"We've got some good options," Clayberg said. "The upside to the injury to Alicia is that it gave Ali the opportunity to step in and develop at the varsity level, so that essentially gives us two returning starters."

The Dutch can also go with 5-8 sophomore Miranda Kouba, who appeared in 33 matches as a freshman and averaged 3.23 digs. Other outside hitter possibilities include juniors Traci Dyer and Jennifer Menary and sophomore Abby Schwennen.

"We should be able to score a lot of different ways on the outside," Clayberg said.

#### **Right-side hitter**

First-team all-conference pick Tessa Prati, a 5-11 senior, returns on the right side. Prati, a team co-captain, averaged a team-high 2.55 kills with a .230 attack percentage, 1.77 digs and 0.59 blocks.

"With Tessa, the right side is a real position of strength," Clayberg said. "She's a very physical, smart player who can control the net with a strong block, but she has the hands and agility to set for us if we need her to. Offensively she really emerged over the last half of the year. The sky's the limit for her."

The Dutch lack right-side experience beyond Prati, but 5-9 junior Whitney Taylor has trained there while Williams and Hansen could slide over as well.

#### **Setter**

Clayberg calls the setter position the deepest on the team. Terri Berger, a 5-5 junior, was a second-team all-league choice and earned league player of the week honors. A team co-captain, she averaged 9.39 assists and displayed offensive aggressiveness by averaging 1.31 kills with a .263 attack percentage and a team-high 47 service aces (0.39 average). She also averaged 1.94 digs and notched five double-doubles.

"Terri's very aggressive, competitive and smart," Clayberg said. "She's a dynamic athlete."

But Clayberg also likes Taylor and 5-8 sophomore Megan Callahan.

"I would be very comfortable with any of the three running the offense," he said. "They're all very different types of setters but they're all strong leaders."

"Whitney (Taylor) has a longer frame and is athletic enough that we could use her as a hitter as well," Clayberg said. "She's developed her understanding of the game and her ability to break a defense down."

"Megan (Callahan) has played some right-back defense for us. She's very composed, very steady and can get into the flow of the game easily."

#### **Defensive specialist**

Maggie Nowicki, a 5-6 sophomore, is the returning starter at libero. She averaged 4.64 digs.

"Maggie took over the starting role the third week of the season," Clayberg said. "She provides great confidence and poise and is a tenacious defender."

Katherine Pugh, a 5-7 senior, is a two-time team co-captain and can provide defensive help as well. She averaged 3.10 digs with 0.47 service aces while appearing in 19 matches last year. Also back is 5-8 sophomore Brittany Van Hemert.

"All three are very competitive and like the challenge of digging strong hitters," Clayberg said. "They're all capable attackers from the back row as well."

#### **The freshmen**

The preseason roster is freshman-dominated, with 22 first-year players.

"It's a large class and it's a class that has great potential," Clayberg said. "The nice thing is they have very quickly assimilated themselves into what Central volleyball is all about. They are very at ease with what they're coming into and are excited about it. They'll make us better."

While it's not ideal to rely extensively on freshmen in varsity action, Clayberg said he won't be afraid to give them playing time if they prove capable.

"It's a class that will come in and challenge our returning players," he said. "The returners are going to have to fight for their spots, which is exactly what we hope for from our freshmen. Their job is to come in and get in the flow as quickly as possible and force us to make tough decisions."

### **The schedule**

Central set a league record with 53 consecutive Iowa Conference match victories from 1996-2001 and is riding a 37-match string entering 2006 but Clayberg expects a fiercely competitive league.

Wartburg, Simpson and Coe joined the Dutch in the league tourney semifinals last year and appear to be top contenders this season.

"Wartburg returns almost everyone," Clayberg said. "Simpson has a very senior-dominated, experienced team and Coe has one of the most athletic teams in the conference. Cornell was young last year but is very well-coached and will contend as well."

The Central schedule remains one of the region's toughest. Central plays in tournaments at perennial powers Washington (Mo.) and Trinity (Texas), with additional strong tourney action at Wis.-Eau Claire and Millikin. The Dutch play host to national contender Wis.-Whitewater in the Central Classic Sept. 22-23 and compete against the top teams in Minnesota at the IIAC-MIAC Border Battle in St. Paul.

The trip to San Antonio, Texas for the Trinity tournament Sept. 29-30 highlights the Dutch schedule.

"We've had a nice series with Trinity and it will be fun to go back to San Antonio, especially with a couple of San Antonio players on our roster," Clayberg said.

Dyer and her sister, freshman right-side hitter Rhiannon Dyer, are graduates of John Marshall High School in San Antonio.

Despite Central's tradition of success, Clayberg has no worries about complacency from his squad, which was bumped from the NCAA Division III tourney last year in a five-game opening-round match at St. Thomas (Minn.).

"We're proud of what we've accomplished at the conference and national levels," he said. "But there's certainly a hunger in these players. They want more. They understand that it's hard to get to the national tournament and that once you get there, everybody's talented. It's just about finding a way to win."
