Kuyper Stadium (1977), the baseball and softball fields (1978), Ryerson Golf Practice Range (2004), tennis courts (1992), soccer field (2005), cross country competition course (2004), and the Ron Schipper Fitness Center (1999). The complex also includes practice and intramural softball, football and soccer football fields. Golf meets are held at the Bos Landen Golf Resort, two miles southwest of the campus on Highway T-15.

Kent Clayberg

Head coach

Kent Clayberg is entering his third season as head volleyball coach and his seventh year on the Central volleyball staff. He was an assistant coach for four years before being promoted to associate head coach in 2002 and then head coach in 2003.

A 1990 Central graduate, Clayberg has compiled a 54-19 record in two seasons as head coach, winning two Iowa Conference titles and two NCAA Division III playoff berths. He shared Iowa Conference coach of the year honors in 2003.

Clayberg has been an instrumental part of a Dutch program which has produced three NCAA Division III championships, nine NCAA playoff berths and nine consecutive Iowa Conference titles, with 14 league crowns overall.

He has twice been selected to coached all-star squads in international competition through USA Athletes International, Inc. He coached a Division III team in the Netherlands in 2001 and took a squad of Division II all-stars to the Northern University Games in Cairn, Australia in 2005.

He previously was an elementary school teacher at Boone, Iowa. He earned his master's degree in education with a concentration in exercise physiology from Iowa State University. He was a student coach for the Cyclone volleyball team for one season and served as a club coach as well. Clayberg is also an assistant director of admission at Central.

Ann Van Hemert

Assistant coach

Ann Van Hemert is in her fourth season as assistant volleyball coach.

A 1999 Central graduate, Van Hemert served as a co-captain of Central's 1999 NCAA Div. III championship team and was a member of four NCAA playoff teams, helping win two national titles while earning three varsity letters.

Van Hemert, a native of Waverly, Iowa and a Waverly-Shell Rock High School graduate, taught and coached for a year in Grinnell, Iowa before returning to Central as an admission counselor.

Catie Brand

Assistant coach

Catie Brand is in her first season as assistant volleyball coach at Central.

Brand, a 2004 Central graduate, was a four-year volleyball letterwinner for the Dutch. The Davenport, Iowa native was a three-time NCAA Division III tournament participant, and a member of Central's 2000 national championship squad.

Brand was a first-team All-Iowa Conference and All-AVCA Division III Central Region selection in 2003 and was twice named the Iowa Conference female athlete of the week. A team co-captain and MVP, Brand closed her career ranking fourth on Central's career kills charts (1,224) and sixth in career blocks (350).

Brand served as a junior high volleyball coach in LeMars for one year and now is a teacher at the Pella Middle School.

Sunny Eighmy

Assistant coach

Sunny Eighmy is in her first season as assistant volleyball coach, working with the junior varsity.

A Guthrie Center, Iowa native, Eighmy is a 1999 Central graduate. She lettered once in volleyball and women's track and field for the Dutch. Eighmy also serves as director of alumni relations for the college.

Outlook

Iowa Conference volleyball championship trophies for the past nine years are safely secured in the Central College trophy case, yet head coach Kent Clayberg finds his 2005 squad entering the year as hungry as a first-time contender.

It's a veteran group. Three starters return, including two all-Iowa Conference players. Senior middle hitter Katie Pederson was a first-team pick last year, while junior right-side hitter Tessa Prati was a second-team selection.

They're among seven returning letterwinners from last season's 28-9 team that posted an 8-0 league record, captured another conference tourney title and earned a ninth NCAA Division III playoff berth.

But the Dutch know that's history and that's reflected in their training for 2005.

"The off-season commitment of these players has been remarkable," Clayberg said. "They love to be together and they love to work hard. I think they've been more diligent in their off-season work than any group we've had."

Yet there are plenty of the familiar preseason questions. Most significantly, the Dutch must find a replacement in the middle for Iowa Conference MVP Jamie Stark as well as for the team quarterback, setter Jodi Taute.

Setter

The early favorite for the setter's job is 5-foot-5 sophomore Terri Berger, who appeared in 47 games in a reserve role as a rookie, averaging 6.28 assists. Clayberg said Whitney Taylor, a 5'9 sophomore, and 5'7 sophomore Jennifer Laughlin are also capable and the Dutch have some incoming freshmen with sterling high school credentials.

"It's a very young group, but they're extremely athletic and intelligent," Clayberg said. "We actually have greater depth at setter than we had last year. The challenge will be finding a way to use them all."

Outside hitter

On the outside, 5'10 senior Alex Costigan is a three-year letterwinner. Last year she averaged 2.53 kills with a .183 attack percentage, 4.67 digs and 0.45 blocks. Costigan will be joined by 5'9 junior captain Alicia Whisner, who moves back after serving as the team's libero, where she averaged 5.2 digs last season. Clayberg notes that Costigan has experience as a libero as well.

"To have outside hitters with that kind of ball control is a huge advantage," he said.

Three sophomores, 5'9 Allison Ripperger, 5'9 Traci Dyer and 5'7 Jennifer Menary, can provide support.

Middle hitter

Pederson, a 6'1 senior captain, hit a team-high .361 last year while also leading the squad with 2.93 kills per game and with 1.06 blocks. Clayberg would like to see 6'1 sophomore Katie Johnson step up and claim the other middle hitter position after lettering as a reserve. She hit .305 with 1.5 kills in 28 games.

"We've got two long, rangy, athletic hitters who can control a match with their hitting and blocking," Clayberg said.

Developing depth is a concern, he conceded. Pederson, a standout high jumper for the women's track and field squad, is coming off a spring-season injury, but Clayberg said she's back at full strength. Nonetheless, he wants to see continued progress from 6' sophomores Megan Hansen and Garra Williams.

"If they progress as well as I expect from their freshman to sophomore seasons, we'll be in good shape," Clayberg said.

Right-side hitter

Prati had a breakout season on the right side, averaging 2.33 kills and 0.73 blocks while hitting .232 with 2.12 digs. She's also a co-captain.

"Tessa's a very athletic right-side hitter who we can use in a lot of different ways," Clayberg said.

Robin Bowers, a 6' senior and 5'9 sophomore Kelli Olson are also right-side candidates. Williams also has experience there and the Dutch could call on Taylor, too.

Libero

With Whisner moving to the outside, defensive specialist Katherine Pugh, a 5'7 junior and team co-captain, averaged 2.58 digs in 19 games last year.

"Katherine made steady progress last season," Clayberg said. "I think she's ready to take over as the full-time libero."

Another option is 5'8 transfer Brittany Van Hemert, along with some strong freshman candidates.

The newcomers

Clayberg feels good enough about his returning players that the Dutch won't be compelled to rush freshmen into action. But he also thinks some of the newcomers could force their way into the picture with their performance.

"There are a few who will push for playing time," Clayberg said. "We've got some who are fully capable of stepping in and helping us right away."

Clayberg is sold on not only the physical skills of his rookies, but their mental approach as well.

"I feel very good about the strength of the freshman class," he said. "We've got a good balance among the positions."

There are some experienced, strong players with great physical potential, but the more impressive thing to me is that they understand what Central volleyball is all about. They know that it's about more than winning trophies and championships. I love the perspective and savvy of this group."

A balanced attack

Clayberg said this year's club isn't dependent on any one area of strength.

"You can't really characterize this team as a good offensive club or a defensive squad," he said. "I think we'll be tough to score against, but I also think we can turn around and put the ball down as well. We've got plenty of power."

The Iowa Conference and beyond

Clayberg likes his team but also recognizes the Iowa Conference is becoming increasingly competitive.

"I don't think the conference lost a lot from last year," he said. "Simpson gave us a run last year and will be right back up there again. Wartburg's got two of the better middle hitters in the conference and lots of physical potential. Dubuque maybe was the most dangerous team in the conference tournament last year. They've got a new coach (Cole Tallman) who is excellent. And Cornell has really been a team on the move in the league in the last couple of years."

The Dutch earned their ninth NCAA Division III tournament berth last year, but made an uncharacteristically quick exit, dropping their first match to Elmhurst (Ill.). Some squads might use that disappointment as motivation for the following year, but Clayberg doesn't see it that way.

"We can't change the past," he said. "There's nothing we can take away from that other than that we played poorly. It's not worth spending a minute of our time this year thinking about that. This is a new team."

Likewise, the Dutch know that while the program has a proud tradition, each victory must be earned.

"These players don't just expect us to win because we're Central," he said. "They're ready to put in the hard work that we need to be successful. That's not just me saying it, that's the attitude of this team."

Central's focus is on the Iowa Conference, but Clayberg thinks the Dutch are capable of sustaining their success in the postseason as well. Central has been ranked in every AVCA national ranking released since 1997. The Dutch again play a schedule loaded with ranked opposition, highlighted by another big trip, this time to the Wellesley (Mass.) Invitational. The Dutch and Wellesley met in the 1998 national semifinals.

"I see no reason why Central can't continue to be a top-10 club," Clayberg said. "But we don't take anything for granted. It will require a lot of hard work. We'll have some ups and downs but we'll just have to roll with it and find ways to be successful."
