The Kuyper Athletics Complex

The Kuyper Athletics Complex is located at the corner of Independence Street and West Fifth Street in southwest Pella. The complex includes P.H. Kuyper Gymnasium (1970), H.S. Kuyper Fieldhouse (1987), A.N. Kuyper Stadium (1977), the baseball and softball fields (1978), Ryerson Golf Practice Range (2004), tennis courts (1992), soccer field (2005), cross country competition course (2004), and the Ron Schipper Fitness Center (1999). The complex also includes practice and intramural softball, football and soccer football fields. Golf meets are held at the Bos Landen Golf Resort, two miles southwest of the campus on Highway T-15.

Doug Stursma

Head coach

Doug Stursma is entering his 13th season as head men's and women's tennis coach at Central, where he has posted a 91-62 dual record in women's matches and a 163-85 men's mark for a combined 254-147 record (.633). He was named the Iowa Conference men's coach of the year in 1996, 1999, and 2000, after piloting the Dutch to league championships in those seasons. He earned league coaching honor in women's tennis in 1994 and 2003.

A Pella native, Stursma is a top amateur player. He has been in the Iowa Tennis Association rankings since 1980 and is currently ranked in the state men's open division. In 2004 he placed 17th in the National 50s Hardcourt Championships in Santa Barbara, Calif.

For eight seasons Stursma was the boys' tennis coach at Pella Christian High School, guiding the Eagles to the Class 1A state championship in 1994 while finishing second in 1995 and third in 1993.

Rod Braun

Assistant coach

Rod Braun is entering his fifth season as assistant women's tennis coach at Central. Braun, an experienced amateur player, served as the head boys' tennis coach at Pella High School for nine seasons. He also was assistant men's tennis coach at Central for three years. An Oregon native, Braun received his bachelor's degree from Oregon State University and a master's degree from the University of Wis.-Whitewater. He is the executive director of the Christian Opportunity Center in Pella.

Outlook

Coach Doug Stursma is confident he'll have a formidable Central College women's tennis lineup this fall. He just doesn't know who will be in it.

Four of last year's top six players return and junior Kristin Kovar appears to be a lock for the number one singles spot. She played four matches at number one last season and was the upset winner of the number two singles crown at the Iowa Conference tournament last year while posting a 10-4 overall record. Kovar also teamed with graduated Tracy Van Zante to take second in the league at number one doubles.

"When she has the right mindset, she can play with almost anyone," Stursma said. "She's a real competitor."

But after Kovar?

"After that, it's kind of a guessing game," he said.

Stursma started the guessing by listing sophomores Katie Moglestad, Jennifer Knobbe and Whitney Visser and juniors Maureen Khairallah and An Lee as contenders for varsity spots. Moglestad (9-5) finished second in the conference at number four singles, with Knobbe (8-6) fourth at number five and Visser (6-7) sixth at number six. Moglestad also teamed with graduated Lindsey Yuska to capture the conference number two doubles crown while Knobbe and Danielle Dowling were second at number three.

"They'll all be important players for us," Stursma said.

Pleasantly complicating the lineup decisions is the arrival of some capable newcomers, most significantly, freshman Hillary Baehr, who was the number one player at Roosevelt High School in Des Moines.

"She's got a lot of talent," Stursma said. "If we can get her to be a little more consistent, she will be a strong player. I expect her to step in and play right away and I wouldn't be surprised if she plays as high as number two."

Another likely contributor is freshman Shela Cleveland of West Des Moines, a former number one player at Valley High School.

"She's a pretty solid player and may help out as well," Stursma said.

The Dutch could also get a boost from sophomore transfer Becky Steenhoek of Pella.

"I'm pretty pleased with the players we have coming in," Stursma said. "Even though we lost a lot, we should still be pretty solid."

Pretty solid may not be enough to hang on to third place in the Iowa Conference. Stursma envisions Luther and Cornell jockeying for first with rapidly improving Coe making a run at third.

"It's going to be a real challenge for us to stay in the top three," he said. "Coe picked up a good recruiting class."

The Dutch face a daunting dual-meet slate as well, adding talented non-conference foes Illinois Wesleyan and Quincy (Ill.) to the schedule.
