Founded in 1853, Central College is a four-year coeducational liberal arts college of the Reformed Church in America. Located 40 miles southeast of Des Moines, Central offers its 1,606 students learning opportunities not only on the Pella campus, but on branch campuses in London and Colchester, England; Merida, Yucatan, Mexico; Leiden, the Netherlands; and Bangor, Wales; and at study centers in Granada, Spain; Paris, France; and Vienna, Austria.

Central is a member of the National Collegiate Athletic Association, Division III, and the Iowa Intercollegiate Athletic Conference. Men compete in baseball, football, basketball, tennis, golf, wrestling, soccer, track and cross country while women compete in tennis, golf, track, softball, volleyball, cross country, soccer and basketball. Rugby is offered at the club level.

The A.N. Kuyper Athletics Complex

The A.N. Kuyper Athletics Complex is located at the corner of Independence Street and West Fifth Street in southwest Pella. The complex includes P.H. Kuyper Gymnasium (1970), H.S. Kuyper Fieldhouse (1987), Ron and Joyce Schipper Stadium (1977) and track (2007), the baseball and softball fields (1978), Ryerson Golf Practice Range (2002), tennis courts (1992), soccer field (2005) and the Schipper Fitness Center (1999). The complex also includes practice and intramural softball diamonds and football fields. Golf meets are held at the Bos Landen Golf Resort, two miles southwest of the campus on Highway T-15.

The Blue Springs, Mo. native was a two-time men's tennis letterwinner for the Dutch and ranks seventh on the school's career doubles winning percentage charts with a 28-15 mark (.651).

Gilmore received a master's degree in exercise science from the University of Iowa in 2002 and served as a graduate assistant athletic trainer.

Tait Smock

Assistant coach

Tait Smock is in his second season as assistant men's tennis coach.

A 2002 Central graduate from Decorah, Smock was a four-year men's tennis letterwinner, 2002 team MVP and a team captain for the Dutch.

Smock racked up a 60-27 career singles record, including a 16-1 mark in 1999, while posting a 59-23 doubles mark. He helped Central win a pair of Iowa Conference team championships and a four-year dual meet record of 62-22.

Outlook

For a Central College men's tennis program that's thrived on stability, it's a year of transition.

Highly successful coach Doug Stursma gave up his position in November after 14 seasons as women's tennis coach and 13 years with the men. Meanwhile the Dutch graduated four of last year's six regulars, including four-time team MVP Nick Cochrane.

But interim coach Greg Gilmore and assistant Tait Smock are both Central graduates who played for Stursma and determined that much will not change, including the team's lofty winning percentage. Central never finished lower than third in the Iowa Conference during Stursma's tenure.

"Obviously you can't replace a Doug Stursma," Gilmore said. "Having played for Doug, I do a lot similar. But my personality is different so there are some things we've tried in practice that are different as well. It's a learning process for everyone, but for the most part, the feedback I've received so far has been very positive."

Replacing Cochrane and his graduated classmates is no easy task, either. However Cochrane's former Fort Dodge High School teammate, junior Jared Feddersen, is moving up to No. 1 singles after finishing 13-9 last year at No. 2.

"Jared had a strong season at No. 2 singles last year and has looked pretty good thus far," Gilmore said. "I really expect him to do some good things at No. 1. He'll see a lot of good competition but I think he'll make the transition pretty

well.”

Getting the first shot at No. 2 singles will be junior Chris Bliss. He was 12-11 at No. 4 last season.

“Chris is a gamer,” Gilmore said. “He really steps up in a big match. I think he’s going to surprise a few people.”

That’s where much of Central’s experience ends. But another Fort Dodge product, freshman Luke Boyd, arrives and will open at No. 3.

“Lucas has really come on in practice,” Gilmore said. “I have the utmost confidence that he’s going to be a fantastic player. He’s going to be a No. 1 for us someday.”

Junior Justin Scherff opens at No. 4. He was 2-0 a year ago.

“Justin has been hitting the ball well,” Gilmore said. “He’s making good decisions both at the baseline and at the nets. I think he will be a solid No. 4 player for us.”

Junior Nick Rohner, who was 2-1 last season, is at No. 5 singles.

“If Nick can maintain his consistency level, he’ll do fine,” Gilmore said.

Senior Devin Bates was 4-1 last year and starts at No. 6. He and Feddersen are sharing captains’ duties.

“Devin has kind of struggled early in the preseason,” Gilmore said. “But his game will develop over the course of the season and chances are he’ll move up. He’s a smart player and moves very well.”

Gilmore would like to go with fairly set doubles combination, starting with Feddersen and Boyd at No. 1.

“Obviously they had experience together in high school,” he said. “Their games are similar yet very complementary. Jared is very consistent and Luke has the ability to put the ball away. They could be a very dangerous combination.”

Scherff is teaming with Bliss at No. 2.

“They’ve looked fantastic so far,” Gilmore said. “They play off each other very well.”

Senior Tyler Cobb joins Bates at No. 3 doubles.

“Tyler’s got a big serve, which will be helpful, especially indoors,” Gilmore said. “If he can maintain a consistent first serve, they’ll do well.”

Gilmore said the Dutch are ready to take on new roles.

“The first couple of matches, I’m sure there will be some nerves,” he said. “But once they get their games in rhythm, they’ll be fine.”

With just eight players it’s not a deep Central squad, which isn’t ideal for practice, but a top-three finish is not out of reach, Gilmore said. He views perennial powers Coe and Luther as the teams to beat with Wartburg not far behind.
