

### **What Every Student Needs before Departing for Granada Summer Program**

There are two program options for Granada Summer: Intensive Language and Language and Culture. When completing their application, students select which program they want to do.

*Intensive Language* is intended for students of all Spanish language levels. It will help quickly improve Spanish reading, writing, listening and speaking skills.

*Language and Culture* is open to students who have completed three or more semesters of college-level Spanish.

If your advisee is planning to participate in one of these summer programs, s/he must complete Central's online application by March 1<sup>st</sup>:

All students are required to attend Central's "First Steps" 1 hour workshop. These workshops are offered throughout the semester.

### **Qualifications**

- Minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5 at the time of acceptance and through departure
- Students who transfer to Central College from another college or university must complete one semester at Central prior to participating in Study Abroad

### **Intensive Language**

The Intensive Language program is aimed a linguistic and social immersion using your own personal experiences. Students receive four hours of instruction daily.

Students take 6 semester hours of credit (6 Spanish language)

### **Language and Culture**

The Language and Culture program will help improve language proficiency while earning credit toward a Spanish major or minor through coursework in art, culture, history and literature.

Students must take a total of 6 semester hours. There are courses that last a total of 45 hours of instruction time and have 3 semester credits and courses with 22.5 hours of instruction for 1.5 semester credits. Students must work with their faculty advisor when choosing courses.

Students choose among:

- Spanish language (45 hours) + one 45 hour elective course
- Two 45 hours elective courses
- Spanish language (45 hours) + two 22.5 hours elective courses
- Four 22.5 hours elective courses

Examples of Electives:

Art: General History and History of Art in Spain (45 hours)

Culture: Spanish and Islamic Civilization and Culture (45 hours)

Culture: Spanish and Latin American Civilization and Culture (45 hours)

Internship: Health internship program (45 hours)

Geography: Geography of Spain (22.5 hours)

Business: Introduction to Business Spanish (22.5 hours)

Internship: Service Learning and Community Internship Program (22.5 hours)
