

### **Internships**

Gain work at an internship in art, business, marketing, theatre, social services and more. The first two weeks of the program consist of classes, activities and excursions that will provide a firm understanding of UK life and its workplaces. For the remaining six weeks, students work at an internship placement, Monday-Wednesday (20 hours) and on Thursdays there are excursions. All internships are non-salaried, for credit only.

There is a full program of excursions and cultural events throughout the 8 weeks including theatre, museums, Hampton Court Palace, Brighton, the East End and a visit to Cambridge.

### **What Every Student Needs Before Departing for London Summer Program**

If your advisee is planning to participate in this summer program s/he must complete Central's online application by March 1<sup>st</sup>:

All students are required to attend Central's "First Steps" 1 hour workshop. These workshops are offered throughout the semester.

### **Qualifications**

- Minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5 at the time of acceptance and through departure.
- \*\*\*\***Note:** It will be difficult to secure an internship in London if the GPA is lower than 2.8.
- Students who transfer to Central College from another college or university must complete one semester at Central prior to participating in Study Abroad

### **Coursework in London Summer Program**

6 semester hours of credit (pass/no record): 3 internship credits and 3 cross cultural credits
